Information from the NYNorth Assembly held May 18th,2024 held via Zoom

- Treasurer Nominated and confirmed
- Alateen coordinator Still needed
- Still need more GRs and DRs...maybe it will help that we decided:
- Everyone can read last Assembly's meetings before the assembly rather than taking up 45 minutes in the Assembly meeting.

WSO:

- There is going to be an overhaul of AFG records
- WSO costs are \$331 per mtg. New York groups are below national average of ~ 200 /group in contributions. Only 61 % of groups give to WSO.
- From p. 28 in the current service manual:
 - The WSO will register groups with names that designate them as being for men, women, parents, adult children, young adults, other gender identification/sexual orientation, etc. with the understanding that, in keeping with Traditions Three and Five, the groups will welcome anyone affected by someone else's drinking.
- When choosing an Al-Anon or Alateen group name, consider the welcoming and comforting focus of Tradition Five. Anyone affected by someone else's drinking is welcome at an Al-Anon meeting. It is vital that group names are inviting, attractive, and avoid public controversy. Our spiritual growth has its roots in the principle of anonymity, to enhance the sense of belonging and unity.

- We made a list of places to drop off literature including police stations, recovery services in western Monroe County. Literature was taken to Rocoverry fitness.
- Fairport library has asked to stock Al-Anon readers.
